

Starlab Stamp Rally Challenge — Official Rules (Colorado)

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

These Official Rules govern the **Starlab Stamp Rally Challenge** (the “Contest”). The Contest is intended to be a **skill-based competition** in which winners are determined by performance **and not by random drawing**.

Contest Overview (Skill-Based)

The Contest is an interactive, industry engagement challenge conducted in connection with the **Space Symposium in Colorado Springs, Colorado**. Participants visit designated partner booths, complete a defined engagement at each booth, and collect a stamp in an official “passport.”

How winners are determined: The first three to finish will be selected as the winners, subject to meeting all requirements in these Official Rules and Sponsor verification.

Eligibility

The Contest is open to individuals who, at the time of entry and participation:

- are **at least 18 years of age**; and
- are attendees of the Space Symposium present on-site in Colorado Springs, Colorado during the Contest Period.

Not eligible: Employees, officers, directors, and agents of Sponsor and its parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising/promotion agencies, and each of their immediate family members (spouse, parent, child, sibling) and household members. Sponsor may also exclude personnel staffing partner booths participating in the Contest.

Void where prohibited.

Contest Period

The Contest begins **Tuesday, April 14 at 7:30 a.m. (MT)** and ends **Wednesday, April 15 at 5 p.m. (MT)** (the “Contest Period”). Sponsor’s timekeeping system is the official timekeeper.

How to Enter (Free) + Entry Requirements

To enter, during the Contest Period:

- Obtain an official **Stamp Rally Passport** from Sponsor or at **Voyager House Coffee Cart, 4 Beech Ave., Colorado Springs, CO 80906**.
- Visit each participating partner booth listed below.
- At each booth, complete the required interaction (typically a **2–3 minute engagement**, such as a brief conversation or activity as directed by booth staff) and obtain that booth’s unique stamp in your passport.
- After collecting all required stamps, proceed to the **Starlab Validation Team “Finish Line”** (i.e. find a designated Starlab representative) within **The Broadmoor** resort complex for validation and time logging. The following individuals qualify as a designated Starlab representative:

No purchase is required to receive a passport, to participate, or to win.

Entry limit: One (1) passport/entry per person and per company for the Contest. Sponsor may disqualify duplicate or manipulated entries.

Participating Partner Booths (Stamp Locations)

To complete the Contest, participants must collect stamps from all designated partner booths. As of publication, participating partner booths include:

- Voyager
- Airbus
- MDA Space
- Space Apps
- Redwire
- Leidos
- Saber

Sponsor may substitute or adjust partner booths due to event logistics, staffing, or partner availability. Any changes will be communicated on-site via Sponsor signage and/or at passport pickup/finish line.

Judging / Performance Standard; Timing; Tie-Breakers

This is a **speed-based performance contest**. The official time used to determine the winners will be verified by Starlab representatives. Participants must present their completed passports to a designated Starlab representative, who will time-stamp the participant's ticket. The stamped ticket will then be reviewed and confirmed by the contest judge.

Start time: Tuesday, April 14 at 7:30 a.m. (MT)

Finish time: The participant's finish time is the time the Starlab Validation Team validates that the passport contains all required stamps and logs completion on the participant's tracking sheet, before collecting that tracking document to be confirmed by the contest judge.

Validation: Sponsor may require participants to present a valid ID and/or Space Symposium badge at validation.

No random drawing: Winners are not selected by lottery or random drawing. **Completion time** determines ranking.

Suggested tie-breaker (skill-based; avoids chance):

If two or more participants have identical validated completion times, the tie will be broken as follows, in order:

- The participant whose passport is recorded as complete first in Sponsor's time logging system (including any higher-precision timestamp data available); and if still tied,

- A **live skill tie-break challenge** administered at the finish line: a short, timed set of **three (3) Starlab and/or space/LEO ecosystem knowledge questions**. The tied participant with the highest score wins the tie; if still tied, the tied participant with the fastest tie-break completion time wins.

Prizes; ARV; Restrictions

Top Finishers (subject to verification): Winners must sign a new reservation agreement within one year and put a down payment on the reservation. The discount applies to costs for up to 6 months of payload space.

- **First Place: 50% off payload lease pricing for one MDLE-sized payload** for a future contracted payload mission aboard Starlab.
- **Second Place: 40% off payload lease pricing for one MDLE-sized payload.**
- **Third Place: 30% off payload lease pricing for one MDLE-sized payload.**

Additional participants: Starlab commemorative items / Starlab SWAG (while supplies last).

Approximate Retail Value (ARV): The Approximate Retail Value (“ARV”) will be established at the time of contract by reference to comparable payloads under then-current market conditions and will be determined based on the specific parameters of the payload to be flown, which may include size, mass, integration requirements, mission profile, and other relevant technical or operational characteristics. The ARV is intended to be reasonable but is not represented as an exact or guaranteed value due to the unique nature of each contemplated payload. The prize is a discount off future contracted services.

Prize restrictions/guardrails (material terms):

- Discounts apply **only to future contracted services** for payload lease pricing for one MDLE-sized payload.
- Prize is subject to **standard customer qualification**, Sponsor’s standard contracting process, and applicable **regulatory and compliance requirements**.
- Prize may not be combined with other discounts or promotions unless Sponsor agrees in writing.
- No cash alternative. Prize is non-transferable except as required by law or approved by Sponsor in writing.
- Winner is responsible for any taxes, fees, and costs not expressly included (e.g., integration costs, licensing, approvals, insurance, transportation, export controls, and any third-party costs), as determined under the eventual contract.

Odds of Winning

Odds of winning depend on the **number of eligible participants** who complete the Contest and the **speed and performance** of participants in completing the required booth engagements and validation.

Winner Notification; Verification; Recognition Event

Potential winners will be identified based on validated completion time and notified **by email/phone** on or about **the morning of Thursday, April 16**.

Winners may be formally acknowledged at a recognition event at **Voyager House on Thursday, April 16 at 11 a.m. (MT)**.

Prize award is subject to verification, including confirming eligibility and compliance with these Official Rules. Until verification is completed, all winners are “potential winners.”

Equal Treatment / No Purchase Advantage

All eligible participants have an equal opportunity to win based on performance. **Purchasing any product or service does not improve chances of winning.** Entry is free, and all valid entries are treated equally under these Rules.

Additional Terms and Conditions

Any discount is expressly conditioned upon (i) the parties' execution of mutually acceptable definitive written agreement(s), and (ii) satisfaction of all applicable contractual, technical, financial, and payment obligations, including any required down payment, in each case as determined by Starlab in its reasonable discretion. By participating in the Challenge, each participant represents and warrants that it is eligible to participate and acknowledges and agrees to comply with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations (including, without limitation, U.S. export control and sanctions laws and regulations, including the ITAR and EAR), and to respect Starlab's and third parties' intellectual property and proprietary rights; Starlab may disqualify any participant or withhold any discount or award where necessary to ensure such compliance.

Participation in the Challenge is voluntary and void where prohibited by law. No purchase or payment is necessary to participate; however, participation does not create any obligation on Starlab's part to enter into any commercial relationship or to provide any discount, award, or other consideration. The Challenge is a skill-based promotional activity, and winners (if any) will be determined based on satisfaction of the stated completion criteria and recorded completion time, subject to verification by Starlab; Starlab's determinations are final and binding to the maximum extent permitted by law.

Any awards provided in connection with the Challenge are offered solely as promotional/commercial incentives in support of potential future Starlab services, have no cash value, and may not be sold, assigned, transferred, exchanged, or redeemed for cash or cash equivalents. Any award is subject to (i) the participant's continued eligibility and compliance with these terms and all applicable laws, (ii) Starlab's standard contracting processes and terms and conditions, (iii) customer qualification (including, as applicable, credit, onboarding, and compliance checks), and (iv) all required internal and external approvals (including regulatory, export/sanctions, and trade compliance approvals); participant is solely responsible for any taxes, duties, or other assessments associated with receipt or use of an award.

Starlab reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, suspend, or terminate the Challenge (or any award) at any time, including without limitation to address fraud, technical failures, safety concerns, force majeure events, or to ensure compliance with applicable laws, regulations, or event conditions. To the maximum extent permitted by law, Starlab will not be liable for any claims, damages, or losses arising out of or relating to participation in the Challenge or any modification, suspension, or termination thereof, except to the extent caused by Starlab's gross negligence or willful misconduct.

Disqualification

Sponsor may disqualify any participant who tampers with the Contest, time logging, stamps, or passport; uses automated, fraudulent, or deceptive methods; behaves in a disruptive, unsafe, or harassing manner at any booth or event location; or violates these Official Rules or event policies.

Publicity

Except where prohibited, participation constitutes consent for Sponsor to use the participant's name, title, company, city/state, likeness, and photographs/video captured during the Contest or recognition event for promotional purposes without additional compensation.

Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, illegible, damaged, or misdirected passports; stamp availability issues due to partner staffing; or technical failures affecting time logging. Sponsor's decisions regarding administration, timing, validation, and eligibility are final to the extent permitted by law.

Privacy / Data Use

Sponsor may collect participant information (e.g., name, email, company, role) for Contest administration and pipeline follow-up related to commercial engagement. <https://voyagertechnologies.com/privacy-policy-2/>

Governing Law; Venue; Void Where Prohibited

The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and is void where prohibited. These Official Rules are governed by the laws of the **State of Colorado**, without regard to conflict-of-laws principles. Venue for disputes shall be state or federal courts located in **Denver, Colorado**, unless otherwise required by applicable law.
